Class iPads across school to support learning (across both Spring and Summer)

- Our intention is to raise funding for class iPads to be used during learning. We are going to fundraise on specific days and prepare items to sell with funds going towards the class iPads.
- On International Education Day 24th January 2024, we would like to organise an own clothes day and ask for any loose change to be brought in as a donation.
- Prior to International Education Day, we are going to make themed book marks to be sold on the day, promoting the importance of education for all. Any money made will contribute to the class iPad fund.
- We will organise and deliver an Easter-themed bake sale with profits being used towards the class iPad fund.
- During the Summer Fair, the Fantastic Fundraisers will plan to have a stall to sell items contributing to the class iPad fund. In the Spring Term, the Fantastic Fundraisers will meet to discuss the details of the stall and items that can be sold for profit.
- During the Summer term, on particularly hot days we plan to sell ice lolly's to our school community and use profits for the class iPad funds.

We will prepare a promotional video for the school community and social media to advertise our intentions for fundraising.

We will make posters and send reminders out to classes prior to each day of donation.

We will ensure that our costs remain as minimal as possible and all funds will go towards our fundraising cause.
