### **Enterprise Fair**

Plans are underway for our annual Enterprise fair and the pupils (and staff!) are very excited. During next week, each class is given £30 to create a product or business idea for the Enterprise Fair. The class that makes the most profit gets to keep it to buy things for their classroom. As you can imagine, the competition is fierce. If any parents have homemade items and would like a stall at the fair, please contact the office, please note there will be a charge of £10 per stall. We cannot wait to see you all supporting your children on 13th December.

KS1 children, including Year 3, will need an adult to walk around the Enterprise Fair with them and can be collected from their classrooms at 1:30pm. Any children who do not have a parent or carer with them will be accompanied by a member of staff. KS2 children will be allowed to walk around the fair without a parent, and KS2 parents can enter through the office and meet their child inside. Children will be allowed to leave with their parents or guardians after the fair; however, Year 6 children will not be released to walk home unaccompanied before 3:15pm. Please also note there will be no Sports Club on this day, but the wraparound afterschool club will be running as usual.

We will also be holding a Tombola, as this is always a favourite, and asking for Tombola prize donations from families. These may be bottles, toiletries, sweets, or other small prizes – a great chance for a clear out pre-Christmas! We will be holding a **non-uniform day on Monday, 9th December**, to collect tombola prize donations. If your child is in Year 5 and has Bikeability, or if your child has PE, please ensure their outfits are suitable for these activities and allow them to participate safely and comfortably.
