Panto and Party Food

Children will enjoy Christmas Party food and will then travel to the Brindley Theatre by coach, leaving school at approximately 12:45pm and **returning at approximately 4.15 pm**. Children are invited to wear their party clothes to school, but they must also wear sensible shoes and a school cardigan or jumper over their outfit for the Panto to ensure they are easily visible.

Year 6 Children will need to be collected from school at 4:15pm and will not be released to walk home without an appropriate adult.

Children are welcome to bring a small bag of sweets to enjoy during the performance; however, we kindly ask that you avoid sending in family-sized bags of sweets. Large quantities can lead to potential sickness, which we want to avoid in the theatre. Keeping snacks to a small, manageable portion ensures a more pleasant experience for everyone. 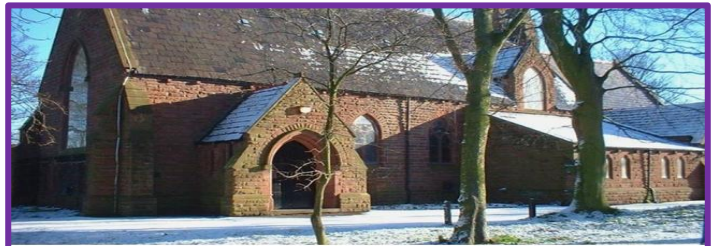
