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Breakfast and After-School Club

We operate wraparound care in the form of a breakfast and after school club which are open to all pupils in the school.

The breakfast club runs each day from 8am until 8.45am, and after school club from 3.15pm until 5.45pm.

The clubs are run by school staff, to ensure that there is continuity and to enable children to feel safe with familiar adults.
