To create plastic recycling stations so other children can recycle effectively	Repurpose old bins by making clear, child Friendly posters so that children know which bins to use. Place the labelled bins in locations that they are likely to be utilised. Children are able to identify and use the different bins for food waste, paper, plastics and general waste.		Posters/signs created for bins so they are clearly labelled and identified
To empty and dispose of plastics recycled correctly.	Eco council to use a rota system to empty the bins weekly, to check that the bins are correctly proportioned and positioned and are in good/clean condition. Eco council to report issues that need to be passed on to site manager.		
Children to litter pick around premises	Children to litter pick during lunch/playtime's to ensure that waste management system is being used and that the school premises is tidy and clean. Children to lead litter-pick sessions and encourage participation and ownership from other children in the school community		

<u>Spring term:</u> reuse action plan (reusing plastics recycled in school to create an art installation and display for the eco council school display.

<u>Summer term:</u> reduce action plan to encourage children that the best way to deal with plastic waste is not by recycling or reusing but by reducing.
