To help children who are struggling in reading so that they can enjoy books	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Reading ambassadors to become reading buddies for children in Y1 and Y2 ▪ Talk to teachers and ask them to nominate children for the reading ambassadors to work with ▪ Set up book boxes to use during reading buddy activities ▪ Reading training for the reading ambassadors so that they can be 'reading leaders' with their buddy ▪ Bookmarks to be given out with reminders of questions to use in reading buddy time 	N/A	
To audit reading books in school to make sure that all children have a range of books at all levels	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Reading ambassadors to complete an audit of the KS2 reading books to see which bands need more books ▪ Discuss with Miss Slingsby to see if we can buy the books needed – arrange fundraising day if needed to help with this 	Approx £1000	
To make sure all classes have a reading area which helps children to develop their love of reading	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Reading ambassadors to use the reading area checklist to do a review of each class ▪ Feedback to each teacher about the reading area and actions identified ▪ Develop a book review book for each class which will help children choose books that they will enjoy. Share with the class and show them how it can be used ▪ Look at the range of reading books in each reading area – discuss with Miss Slingsby if there are classes which need more books. Fund raising activities if needed? 	TBC – this will depend on the book audit and what is needed in each class	
To plan an exciting World Book Week for the school	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Reading ambassadors to meet and share ideas for activities that could take place during World Book Week – compose a list and meet with Miss Slingsby and Mrs Bonnett to decide which ones we will complete ▪ Reading Ambassadors to meet with staff during a staff meeting to discuss WBD ideas ▪ Arrange a book swap shop – information to go in the newsletter to ask for book donations ▪ Arrange a competition for children to design their own front cover of their favourite book – reading ambassadors to launch competition in a whole school assembly 	Prizes for the competition - £30
