## Maths

### Numbers to 10 Addition and subtraction within 10 Shape and patterns

- Represent, compare and explore numbers within 10.
  - One more and one less
  - Doubling and halving
- Represent and explain addition and subtraction.
  - Commutativity
  - Addition and subtraction facts
- Identify, describe 2-D and 3-D shapes
  - Investigate repeating patterns
- Use and follow instructional and positional language

## Science

### Animals including Humans

- We will identify, name, draw and label the basic parts of the human body and say which part of the body is associated with each sense.
- We will identify and name a variety of common animals including fish, amphibians, reptiles, birds and mammals that are carnivores, herbivores and omnivores.
- We will describe and compare the structure of a variety of common animals (fish, amphibians, reptiles, birds and mammals, including pets)

## LUNAR

### In grammar we will be focussing on:

- Hold pencil with correct grip, form lower case letters with developing accuracy
- Form capital letters correctly using the RWI handwriting scheme
- Form digits 0-9 correctly using the number formation rhymes

### The United Kingdom

Through this Geography unit, the children will be exploring where they live in a lot more detail. They will:

- name the four countries of the UK.
- know they live in England.
- locate the four countries of the UK on a map of the UK.
- identify characteristics of the four countries of the UK.
