


Autumn in Year 1

Maths

Numbers to 20 Addition and subtraction within 20

- Identify, represent, compare and order numbers to 20
 - Doubling and halving
 - One more and one less
 - Represent and explain
- addition and subtraction strategies including 'make ten'
- Use known facts to add and subtract

Science

- We will identify, name, draw and label the basic parts of the human body and say which part of the body is associated with each sense.
- We will identify and name a variety of common animals including fish, amphibians, reptiles, birds and mammals that are carnivores, herbivores and omnivores.
- We will describe and compare the structure of a variety of common animals (fish, amphibians, reptiles, birds and mammals, including pets)

In grammar we will be focussing on:

- Hold pencil with correct grip, form lower case letters with developing accuracy
- Form capital letters correctly using the RWI handwriting scheme
- Using oracy to hold sentences
- Sequencing sentences to form a short narrative
