This term our writing will be inspired by Onjali Q. Rauf's novel, *The Boy at the Back of the Class*.

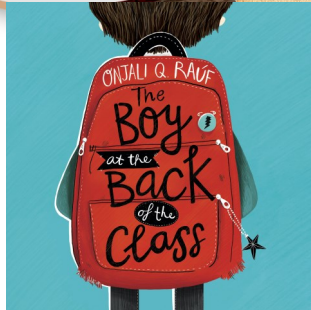
We will be writing:
