This term our writing will be inspired by *Once*, a novel which tells the story of a young boy during WW2.

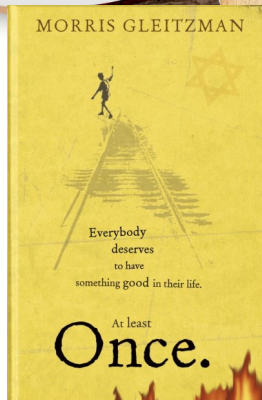
We will be writing:
