

Wide Awake to the World Week

This week the whole school has taken part in our annual 'Wide Awake to the World Week'. During this week, each class looks at current global issues and children in our world are not accessing all of the Unicef Children's Rights. Each class then chooses a cause to campaign for, using their voice to be the change needed in our world. We have been blown away by the children's responses to this project and their mature and empathetic approach to their campaigning. The rights that the classes have been campaigning for have ranged from the right to be safe from war and the right to clean water, to the right for an education and the right to a safe home. Even Reception have gotten involved discussing a child's right to play! Over the next few weeks, we will be sharing more of our Rights Respecting work with adults at home, to help you build a better understanding of the rights and what it means to us as a Rights Respecting School.

Admittance to Holy Communion Service

Today was our Admittance to Holy Communion service for Y4, Y5 and some Y6 pupils, which was led by Arch Deacon Simon and our own Reverend Linda. This is a special stage in the children's faith journey, where they take part in their first Eucharistic service and receive bread and wine for the first time. The children received special candles and certificates to mark the occasion, and enjoyed a celebration of cake and biscuits back at school afterwards.
