Pupil Leadership Afternoon

This week started with our first pupil leadership group meetings. This year every child from Y2 – Y6 are in a pupil leadership group and will be involved in leading different projects throughout the year. <u>Community Crusaders</u> – working to build links within the community, helping to bring the school and other areas of the community together, working to support our local community where we can

<u>Fantastic Fundraisers</u> – This group will lead the fundraising in school. This might be for the school, for local charities, or for national days such as Red Nose Day etc

<u>Eco Educators –</u> This group will be working to educate our school family on key issues, as well as looking at ways in which we can improve our current practices at school and at home to be better global citizens.

<u>Guardians of the Grounds</u> – This group are looking at how they can improve and take care of our school grounds. This might be litter picking, improving the environment by planting flowers or painting, looking for ways to make our school safer.

<u>Wellbeing Warriors -</u> This group is leading the way with keeping our wellbeing at the forefront. This could be our mental, physical or emotional wellbeing.
