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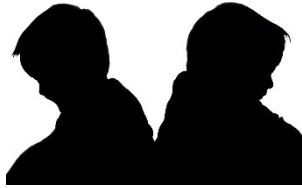

I feel worried!



- I'm being bullied – someone is being unkind to me physically or emotionally
- Something has happened at home that is making me uncomfortable, unhappy or scared
- Someone is hurting or threatening me
- I've seen or heard something online that has upset, scared or made me uncomfortable
- Another problem

NOTHING is ever too small or silly.

What can I do?



- Tell my parent, family member, or another trusted adult
- Tell a trusted adult in school.
- Write down what is upsetting me and pass it to an adult in school.
- Use your talking pebble to show you want to talk to someone.
- Use the Whisper button the school website to send a message.

Who can I talk to in school?

You can talk to anyone in school about anything that is upsetting or worrying you, this could be:
